








Anti-Ragging Committee meeting held

Minutes: —

The meeting started at 10.15 AM. The Principal welcomed the members and stressed that the college is a Ragging-free campus. There have been only one or two allegations of ragging since the inception of the college. He also briefed the previous students' violence in the campus which occurred during Onam celebration and the students' violence after the celebration that resulted in the present allegation of ragging.

After having a detailed discussion on the complaint of ragging and the need for a sub-committee constituted to probe into the complaint

of Ragging, the Committee took the following decisions:

(1) To entrust a Sub-Committee of the Anti-Ragging Committee, consisting of the following members, with investigating thoroughly into the complaint dated 12.09.2023 from a junior Student, alleging ragging and to submit its report at the earliest.

- i) Mr. P.A. Sadikhe Faculty, Law
- ii) Mr. Girish M. Faculty, Law
- iii) Mrs. Sanitha P. Faculty, Mgt.
- iv) Mr. Mohamed Shareef A. AO
- v) Mr. Ibrahim Librarian

(2). To recommend to conduct an Anti-Ragging class to the students with the help of the District Legal Services Authority.

(3) To recommend to conduct motivational classes to students so as to promote them to abstain from violence and to concentrate on academic activities.
